The Outstanding Young Agrologist Award is presented to a Saskatchewan registered agrologist under the age of 40 for professional distinction associated with outstanding service and contributions to agriculture, bioresources, food or the environment.

ELIGIBILITY: This award is open to **active Professional Agrologists (PAg)** and **Technical Agrologists (TechAg)** **under the age of 40**.

DEADLINE: Email completed forms to info@sia.sk.ca before **November 15**.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Follow the instructions carefully and provide as much information as possible to assist in the accurate assessment of nominees.

Unsuccessful nominations will not be automatically reconsidered next year. However, they may be updated and resubmitted by the nominator in subsequent years.

The granting of an award to a fully registered agrologist does not carry any exemption from payment of licencing fees.
